Treasurer Report: JT (8 Minutes)

- No big changes or concerns. Income numbers are way higher than we expected so we are looking great. We expected 24K shortfall but instead we have a 66K surplus!! (Maybe not 100% but definitely a surplus) OP account has 52K plus CD has 20K plus around \$500 interest.
- Admin Asst salary changes: see excel spreadsheet. SA was hourly for a set number of hours in 2022 but kept going over. She was changed to salary in 2023 at \$7200/year and then increased again to \$750/month = \$9K annually. For 2024 salary was increased to \$9900. Percentage change is high but dollar amounts are not that big.
- **Parish Admin:** Parish admin is making less annually than Admin Asst. \$8400 vs \$9900. Does this need to be addressed? Should the same percentage increases be applied to the Parish Admin?
- Discussion about savings CD and what we should do for the future. We got a good return and it rolls in 6 days. Motion made to roll the CD and the interest for another 6 months.
